

ELECTRICAL INSPECTORATE

As per Indian Electricity Rules 1956 every new electrical installation should be inspected and approval obtained from appropriate Electrical Inspectorate.

1. Inspections shall be carried out by the Electrical Inspector after receiving the application along with the test results from the concern department/contractors on completion and Installation of the works. (Submission of application within 30 days of completion Installation).
2. Electrical Inspectorate has slandered fees for the inspection as per the Govt. Notification of Schedule of Inspection fee. (After three days of the receipt of application).
3. The party concern shall remit the inspection fee in the form of treasury Challan under the Head of Account 0043- duties and Taxes on Electricity.
4. After receiving the paid treasury challan, the Electrical Inspector and concern party will fix the inspection date. (within seven days)
5. After the inspection of the Electrical Installations, the Electrical Inspector if finds it satisfactory, the Chief Electrical Inspector will issue the clearance for commissioning the Lines, Sub-stations, Generator set etc. If the Electrical Inspector finds that the work was not executed as per specification and standard as specified in the test result, then the Electrical Inspector shall give direction to the party concern to rectify the same and inform the Electrical Inspectorate for further Inspection.(After four days of the joint inspection).
